What is Project Management?

Project management refers to the work of leading a team to achieve targets within a set deadline and budget. It requires the application of processes, methods, skills, knowledge and experience to achieve specific project objectives according to the project acceptance criteria. Project managers need to optimize the allocation of human resources and tasks to complete a project, which requires a different set of skills from those of business managers.

OVERVIEW

Project management is the process of leading the work of a team to achieve goals and meet success criteria at a specified time.

The primary challenge of project management is to achieve all of the project goals within the given constraints.

This information is usually described in project documentation, created at the beginning of the development process.

The primary constraints are scope, time, quality, and budget.

The secondary challenge is to optimize the allocation of necessary inputs and apply them to meet pre-defined objectives.
